

Q: What is a faith promise?

A: A faith promise establishes a plan to give to God's work as He provides. The promise is fulfilled out of His abundant resources and grace.

You will not receive any notices or reminders of your faith promise, but we will enclose an envelope for your next contribution with each receipt. A faith promise is not a legally binding pledge, but rather a promise to God.

Contributions to InFaith are tax deductible. Your contributions, according to IRS rules, are given to InFaith and, therefore, may be used wherever they are most needed. However, we make every effort to honor your desire to support a particular area of ministry.
