



PARTICIPATION INFO & AGREEMENT

CAMP HIGHLINE is a Christian mountain bike camp sponsored by InFaith, a non-denominational, non-profit mission organization.

CAMP HIGHLINE will offer mountain bike skills training and trail riding opportunities along with fun, food, and fellowship aimed to offer spiritual encouragement in a loving environment led by skilled and supportive staff. The program will feature enduro and downhill riding experiences and instruction from professional level riders. This 2021 program is designed for high school boys with an intermediate level riding ability (2 years experience min.) and will include: transportation to trails, five healthy meals, rustic camping for two nights, messages from the Bible, other fun camp activities, and a possible swim in local river and/or lake. Each participant must provide his own bike (full suspension), riding gear, and personal items on the What to Bring List*.

CAMP HIGHLINE will be operated in alignment with the Statement of Faith* and Ministry Essentials* of InFaith with the goal of sharing the love of Jesus Christ and Biblical truths with each participant to help him/her grow in relationship with God.

CAMP HIGHLINE will be held September 24-26, 2021. Check-in 3-3:30 pm. Check-out Sunday 4-4:30 pm.

CAMP HIGHLINE Base Camp will be located on the Middle Fork S Ranch: 42999 SE 120th Street (Thrasher Rd) North Bend, WA 98045. Property is not available to the public before or after the designated camp program. Field Trips will be made to various trails which may include but not be limited to: Raging River, Tiger Mountain, Snoqualmie Summit, Duthie Hill, Olallie Park, Roslyn area, and North Bend pump track.

CAMP HIGHLINE Volunteer Staff will be verified and approved by InFaith. The Event will be coordinated by Camp Director, Keith Stringfellow, InFaith: keiths@infaith.org 760-505-0119, and Program Director, David Stringfellow.

CAMP HIGHLINE has the following requirements to participate:

- All campers will attend all activities of the program and remain under supervision of designated camp staff. No camper will be forced to ride a trail or an obstacle of which he is not comfortable.
- All campers will follow camp rules including safe riding, respect of property owners, clean language and behavior, and mutual respect for fellow campers and staff.
- All campers will arrive at camp prepared with a good working bike that is ready to ride and personal supplies for camp. Tools and mechanic help will be available as needed during program.*

CAMP HIGHLINE registration fee is \$270. Registration will initially be limited to 20 high school participants who submit all forms with a minimum deposit of \$135 or payment in full. This fee and forms are due about 2 weeks before camp on September 7th (postmarked). The balance must be paid in full at the time of camper check-in on Sept 24th.

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Camp Highline will include mountain bike riding on a variety of terrain that can be dangerous including but not limited to: rocks, logs, trees, steep downhills, narrow trails, jumps, wet slippery ground, and other riders. The program will include shuttle van and personal vehicle transportation to other properties for riding on trails, dirt/gravel roads, pump track, etc. The experienced staff are committed to promoting the enjoyment and preserving the health and safety of all riders by emphasizing proper riding techniques, controlled riding, adult supervision, and not forcing anyone. A suitable bike, all personal safety equipment and previous rider experience are required. A river or lake swim may be offered as an optional activity depending upon weather and parent permission.

I acknowledge that participation in the activity described above involves risk to the participant (and to the participant's parents or guardians, if the participant is a minor), and may result in various types of injury including, but not limited to, the following: sickness, exposure to infectious/communicable disease, bodily injury, death, emotional injury, personal injury, property damage, and financial damage.

In consideration for the opportunity to participate in the activity described above (the "activity"), the participant (or parent/guardian if the participant is a minor) acknowledges and accepts the risks of injury associated with participation in and transportation to and from the activity. The participant (or parent/guardian) accepts personal financial responsibility for any injury or other loss sustained during the activity or during transportation to and from the activity, as well as for any medical treatment rendered to the participant that is authorized by the sponsor or its agents, employees, volunteers, or any other representatives (collectively referred to as the "activity sponsor"). Further, the participant (or parent/guardian) releases and promises to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the activity sponsor for any injury arising directly or indirectly out of the described activity or transportation to and from the activity, whether such injury arises out of the negligence of the activity sponsor, the participant, or otherwise.

If a dispute over this agreement or any claim for damages arises, the participant (or parent/guardian) agrees to resolve the matter through a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process. If the participant (or parent/guardian) and the activity sponsor cannot agree upon such a process, the dispute will be submitted to a three-member arbitration panel for resolution in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

I understand, consent to, and authorize in advance, the use of my name, voice, picture or other likeness in combination or alone, in any broadcast, telecast, print medium, advertising, promotion or other account of Camp Highline / InFaith.

I agree to assume any costs of mechanical repairs/part that may be necessary for my child, or me, to resume participation in camp activities, and do grant camp staff permission to secure such repairs that camper deems necessary. Effort will be made to contact parent prior to incurring any expense.

I represent that my minor child, or I, are in sufficiently good physical condition to participate in the programs and activities of Camp Highline without jeopardizing our health. I understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing this waiver and release, and sign it voluntarily.
